Dear Hilary:

Thanks for your note of the 24th. We will look forward to your visit with great anticipation. I have talked with Josh, and he assures me that he would be delighted to have you stay with Esther and him. Consequently, we will cancel the reservations we are holding for you at the Faculty Club.

I note that you are planning to leave for home on Wednesday afternoon at 2:30 p.m. I would like to take you up on your kind offer to extend your stay because we have you scheduled through the afternoon of the 2nd. There are flights to Philadelphia from here in the morning but, of course, the time loss means that you will get in late in the afternoon. United's 60 leaves here at 9:35 a.m. and gets to Philadelphia at 5:25 p.m., and that's the only non-stop morning flight. If you want to be in Philadelphia earlier, on Thursday, and don't mind flying at night, you can easily work things out; I will leave it to you to do what seems most satisfactory.

In respect to your coming down from Berkeley, the best thing for you to do would be for you to take a helicopter. Depending on when you can get away, there are flights from Berkeley to the San Francisco Airport at 3:49 p.m., 5:25, 6:20, 7:20, 8:25, and 9:19. The flying time is between ten and twenty minutes (I don't know why it varies but it does).

There is an excellent limousine service from the San Francisco Airport to Palo Alto. They will pick you up at the terminal and deliver you to Josh's house.

Let me suggest the following procedure. If you can call me some time Monday morning and indicate what flight you are taking from Berkeley to the San Francisco Airport, we will arrange for the limousine to meet you. The driver will look for you at the American Airline baggage area; he will have your name and flight number. If I am not available when you call here, ask for Mrs. Lindquist and she will take care of the limousine reservations.

I am enclosing herewith a tentative schedule for your visit; this can be altered if need be.
