The best arrangement it has been possible to make for temporary computing assistance for the T.M.V. research is that the work should be divided into three parts as follows.

The first part of the computation will be done by Mrs. Piper (34, Lavender Gardens, S.W.11), working at home. The estimated cost of this is approximately £25.

Miss Margaret Mitchell (46, Radnor Road, Harrow), will work for three weeks. Miss Mitchell has Higher Certificate in mathematics, and is aged 18½. It seems that £4 - 10 per week would be a suitable payment. (She will have to spend 15 shilling per week on fares)
