Dear Dr. Kunicki-Goldfinger:

Thank you for your letter of July 4th. Since our earlier correspondence I have been obliged to change my plans slightly and I hasten to tell you about this. I will not be returning directly to Montreal from Stockholm, but instead, have plans to make a rather more extensive trip involving a return to Madison ~~from~~ San Francisco instead. Consequently, I will not be back here in Madison until about the 11th of September. I hope that it will be convenient for you to adjust your plans accordingly. I will, of course, see you at Stockholm and we may be able to work out the details there. If it is essential for you to arrive earlier, I can undoubtedly arrange to have one of my colleagues from the Department meet you, but it would not be convenient to start any experimental studies until my return. I will be leaving Madison for a Bacteriophage Research Conference at Royaumont just two weeks from today. If I do not hear by mail from you by then, I will look forward to seeing you in Stockholm. If you have any cultures that you would like to include in your brief work here, I suggest that you mail them to yourself in care of me at this address with instructions on the label to refrigerate them until my return. I am sure this would be more convenient for you than to carry them from one Congress to another.

I hope this late change in plan does not unduly inconvenience you and I apologize for any difficulty it may cause.
