Having been accustomed to the familiar representations of John D. Rockefeller at an age that most of us would be in dotage, I was pleasantly surprised to find a portrait that had been executed by Eastman Johnson in 1895. This reflects a character showing some of the vigor that, whatever else might be said, can hardly be denied to the life and career of the founder of both of our institutions!
