To: Dean R. K. Froker, College of Agriculture


Dear Dean Froker:

Professor Irwin suggested that I file the following information with your office in pursuance of current policies on "outside employment".

As of this month, I have entered into a rather informal consultantship arrangement with Dr. J. Lein of the Bristol Laboratories, Inc., Syracuse, N.Y., to advise on their programs of screening and mutation for novelties and improvements in antibiotic production. The work involved is not expected to exceed 4 to 5 hours per month. I have a small monthly retainer for the consultation, with provision for per diem payments for any special talks. I have taken pains to exclude from the consultation any material that might be construed as special access to research results from this laboratory, prior to publication.
